Robert Mosier (USA)-quilt, sculpture

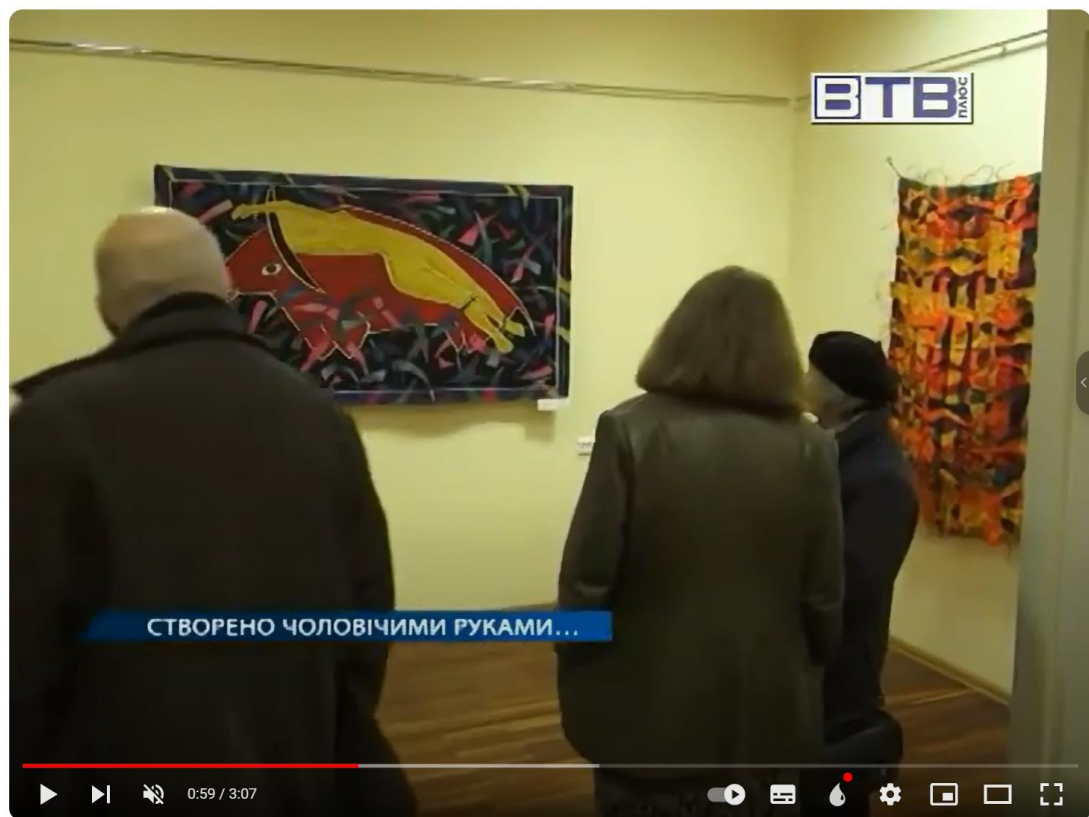
